## Overview:

Our Kinder Cove is a dedicated space complete with a courtyard, garden, chill zone, and private restrooms. The summer kinder program implements a wide range of activities in STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math), arts, sports, recreation, and more!

### Elementary Grades

Age groups rotate between the Games Room, Ed/Tech Center, Art Room, Gym, and Playground. Campers will play, learn, and grow collaboratively as they participate in our diverse and interactive Club experience.

### Middle School

Members can socialize with friends, play their favorite games in their own Club space, and participate in the arts, sports, and STEM programs.

- Participants will learn about Batik Art and its origins, experiment with Printmaking and learn more about its history, and create a tie-dye t-shirt and tote bag.

- **Wednesday**
