WHO QUALIFIES?

ELOP (Expanded Learning Opportunity Program) scholarships are provided through LBUSD for families that meet one of these prerequisites:

- Low Income Identified through the LBUSD Annual Household Income Survey
- English Learner
- Students experiencing homelessness
- Foster Youth

WHAT DOES THE ELOP SCHOLARSHIP COVER?

- School Year Monthly Fees (School Year Registration Fee also covered)
- School Bus Pass to Boys & Girls Club
- 6 weeks of Camp
 - Applicable towards Summer, Winter, Mid-Winter, and/or Spring Break Camps (Not \$100 Membership for summer)

ADDITIONAL FEES (NOT COVERED)

Summer Camp registration required: \$100
