



## **CANYON BRANCH: SUMMER CAMP OVERVIEW 2026**

Get ready for nine weeks of fun, safe, and engaging programs filled with learning, outdoor adventures, and group activities. Our full-day camp keeps kids active, trying new things, and building new friendships. Along the way, they'll also enjoy exciting field trips, special events, and themed days! Canyon Branch features the Games Room, an Education and Technology Center, an Art Room, a Teen Center, Outdoor Playground, a "Chill Zone," a snack bar, a full-size Gym, and a dedicated space for kindergarteners.

### **Summer Groups**

**All members are considered to be in the grade they just finished during the previous school year.**

#### **Kinder Cove**

The Kinder Cove is a dedicated space complete with a courtyard, garden, chill zone, and private restrooms. The summer kinder program implements a wide range of activities in STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math), arts, sports, recreation, and more! Summer members must be 5 years old or older. While we operate as an afterschool program during the school year, our summer program serves as a recreational camp specifically for school aged members.

#### **Elementary Grades**

Grade groups rotate between the Games Room, Ed/Tech, Art Room, Gym, and Playground. Members will play, learn, and grow collaboratively as they participate in our diverse and interactive Club experience.

#### **Middle School & High School**

Members can socialize with friends, play their favorite games, and participate in the arts, sports, and STEM programs in their own Club space.

## **Camp Details**

### **Things to Bring**

- Pack lunch or have a current snack bar account to purchase lunch
- Water bottle
- Closed toe shoes
- Please note cell phones are not allowed at the club. Personal tech devices are only allowed during tech time on Friday afternoons

### **Beach Tuesdays**

*Beachgoers will be shuttled or walk to Diver's Cove for some fun in the sun. Remember to pack your child with a lunch as they will eat at the Club before departing.*

- Shuttle leaves the Club at 12:30 p.m.
- Parent pick-up at Diver's Cove no later than 5:00 p.m.
- Must be able to swim!
- Pack a water bottle, sandals to change into, sunscreen, extra snacks, and a towel
- Recommended to wear a rash guard or swim shirt.

### **Water Blast Tuesdays**

*On select Tuesdays, Members can engage in fun water activities and waterslides at the Club. Waterblast is from 1:00pm - 3:00pm*

- Bring a pair of closed-toe water shoes, sunscreen, a towel, and a change of clothes as you will get soaked!
- If members cannot change into their swim gear by themselves, they cannot participate in Waterblast activities

### **Field Trip Wednesdays**

*Members must have been registered with a signed permission slip to attend Wednesday's field trips.*

- The bus will not wait for late members on trip days.
- Members cannot be dropped off or picked up at field trip locations.
- Season passes are not accepted.
- Members are allowed to bring extra money for souvenirs and extra snacks.
- Lunch is included on Wednesday's field trips.
- Age requirement varies by field trip.
